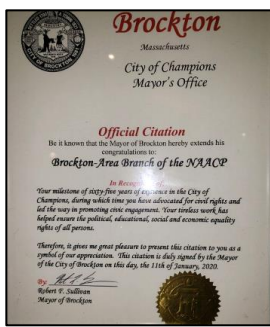


# Brockton Area Branch NAACP – 2020 Year End Review

➤ Citation from Mayor Sullivan in recognition of our 65<sup>th</sup> Anniversary



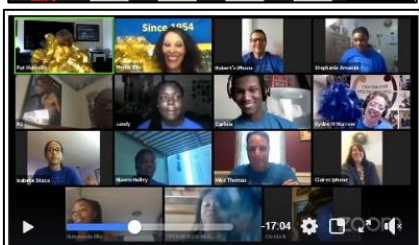
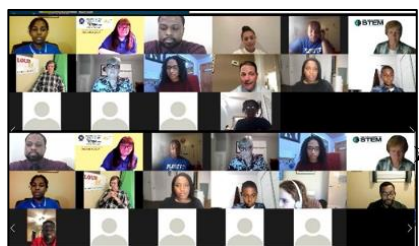

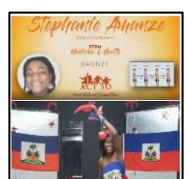
